## How the projects work:

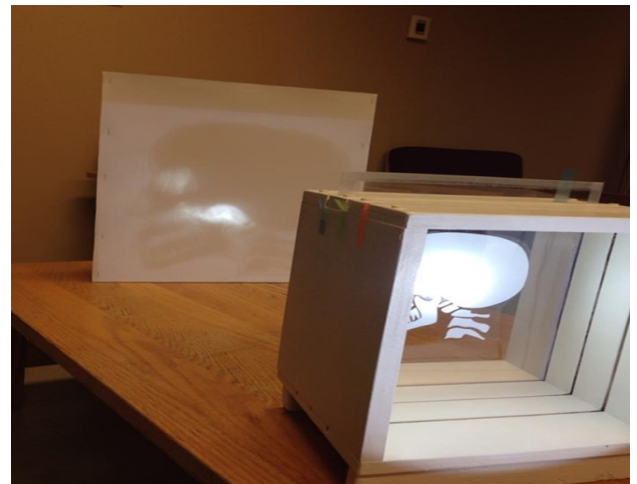
These partnership projects are supported by engineering professors, librarians, and technical staff. Student teams have a small budget for materials and services.
